uba is reopening all its borders to international travel on November 15, a decision that takes into account the positive control scenario in the face of COVID-19, the tendency to a decrease in cases in all its provinces and the expected immunization of 90% of its inhabitants by November. In addition, airport, hotel and other personnel who interact with travelers have been the first to be vaccinated and will get a booster dose to reinforce their protection.

This will make it possible to implement measures such as the elimination of the mandatory quarantine for travelers as of November 7, the return of mobility between provinces (which boosts the development of tourist circuits) and the revival of cultural activities.

The health protocols are being adapted to the new context, since upon arrival, the international vaccination certification will be required from travelers. Failing that, they must show the negative result of a PCR performed no more than 72 hours before arrival in Cuba. At the entry points to the country, health personnel will carry out temperature checks and take random samples, while epidemiological surveillance is maintained in the accommodation facilities.





Other markets such as Mexico, Panama and the Dominican Republic are also increasing their presence in the island's tourist environment. Cubana de Aviación is resuming its routes from Argentina and Spain, and other traditional airlines such as Air France, Air Europa and Iberia are increasing their flights. Tourists from the Asian continent will have Turkish Airlines, which will connect this region of the world with the Cuban capital.

All these elements make it possible to expect the arrival of some 100,000 international tourists in the period between November 15 and the end of the year. The response of the tour operators and airlines has exceeded expectations, a fact that allows trust in a very encouraging winter.

Travelers will find in Cuba renovated facilities and a multitude of new services, such as improvements in Internet connectivity, the use of free Wi-Fi for 30 minutes at airports, the new platforms for the online sale of services and the ease of making digital payments.

The tourism authorities in Cuba invite vacationers from all over the world to visit a renewed and safe destination, which has thousands of attractions in its beaches, cities and nature reserves. All conditions have been created and travelers will especially feel the hospitality of the Cuban people, ready to again welcome friends from all over the world.

In private rental houses, the owners are responsible for timely reporting any guest with symptoms. Tourists with a positive PCR will be transferred to health institutions for their attention and care. The mandatory use of a mask is maintained within air and port terminals, as well as throughout the country.

The ten international airports throughout the archipelago, as well as marinas and other arrival points, are ready for reopening. There is great interest among the tour operators that work the Cuba Destination, and numerous requests have been received from Canada, the United Kingdom and other European countries. Russia, a market that has been flying to Varadero and Cayo Coco for several weeks, is planning growth based on itineraries that depart from new cities.

Cubana de Aviación resumes flights to Buenos Aires

ubana de Aviación is resuming its flights between Buenos Aires and Havana as of this November 22, with departures every Monday at 12:30 a.m. from the Ezeiza terminal, in the Argentine capital, and arrival in Cuba at 8:30 a.m. on the same day.

For November and December, Cubana de Aviación will operate the weekly flight to Havana, and starting January it will add trips to Cayo Coco, a tourist destination highly appreciated by travelers from Argentina and the rest of the Southern Cone countries. Ticket sales are available at the airline's office in Buenos Aires, located at 552 Sarmiento Street. Queries can also be made through the emails: reservas@cubanadeaviacion.com.ar and pasajes@cubanadeaviacion.com.ar

Those interested can also contact the travel agencies Havanatur Argentina, Julia Tours, OLA, Freeway, Eurovips, Tip Travel, Top Dest, Logan Travel, Station Travel and Soles Viajes.

To enter Cuba travelers must show the certificate or document that accredits the international vaccination scheme, and those not vaccinated must present the negative result of a PCR test made a maximum of 72 hours before their arrival. Passenger temperature control will be maintained at the entry airports and independent random tests will be carried out according to the opinion of the health authorities (PCR or antigen test).

Complying with sanitary protocols is essential, as part of the Tourism + Hygienic and Safer program that Cuba has designed to guarantee the safety of travelers in all tourist services.

The Canadian airline OWG is a subsidiary of the Quebec-based charter airline Nolinor Aviation, and in July of last year announced the partnership with Hola Sun/Caribe Sol.

Canadian travelers will be able to visit again destinations such as Santa Clara and the nearby keys of its north coast, among them Cayo Santa María, which offers perfect hotels for trips with the family, for couples or with friends. They can also visit cities like Trinidad, with its cobbled streets, its artisans and its museums. In Cienfuegos they can tour the beautiful city, visit the dolphinarium or go diving at Rancho Luna. In Cuba's eastern region they will be able to fly to Holguín and enjoy its beautiful beaches, or to Santiago de Cuba, the most Caribbean of Cuban cities.

In Cuba, as in the hotels and non-hotel facilities which have the Tourism + Hygienic and Safer certification, the airports that will receive the OWG flights have gone through a process of certification and preparation of their personnel.

All are ready to provide the required attention to travelers, following the recommendations of the World Health Organization and the national Ministries of Public Health and Tourism to guarantee health safety in all their processes.




Cuba, Best Cultural Destination in Caribbean WORLD TRAVEL AWARDS

uba was crowned as the winner of the famous World Travel Awards 2021, in the category "Best Cultural Destination" in the Caribbean region. The information released on the official WTA website refers to Barbados, Bermuda, Jamaica, Martinique and Puerto Rico among the other nominated countries.

Centennial of the Bodega Don Pancho

Where Cuban Rum's secrets are keep

here are many good reasons to visit
Santiago de Cuba, the most Caribbean of
the country's cities, and also the cradle of
Cuban rum, as many know it in the world. To
honor that second reason, today we invite you to
visit one of the city's treasures, closely linked to
its history and traditions: the so-called Cathedral
of Cuban Rum.







According to the archives of the province of Santiago de Cuba and the testimony of the Rum Masters of the Hero City, the name of Don Pancho is due to the fact that its first manager's name was Don Francisco Savigne y Lombard, whom they called Pancho. It is said that this man participated in the war of 1895 with Emilio Bacardí Moreau, who was the first mayor of the city of Santiago de Cuba. At that time, at the beginning of the 20th century, Bacardí was the president of the rum company and when the aging warehouse opened, he appointed Francisco Savigne as manager.

Currently the Don Pancho warehouse is the largest in the country, both in size and also in the amount of aged liquid. It is the one that houses the most barrels with the oldest aged rum bases in Cuba.

Santiago de Cuba, with more than 500 years of history, treasures the secrets of the elaboration of Cuban light rum, an exquisite mixture that has as its sacred place the Cathedral of Cuban Rum, a title very well given to the Bodega Don Pancho, which is reaching its 100 years of existence.

It opened its doors in 1921 and since then it has protected the bases of aged rums. It has been a witness and executor of the creation of the exquisite blends that the Cuban Rum Masters turn into famous and prized rums. In this almost magical space, between white oak barrels, more than a century and a half of traditions are preserved, related to the technique of distillation and aging. Everything that comes out of Bodega Don Pancho carries a quality seal, which is recognized by experts and clients from all over the world.

never sleeps inside the barrels. The truth is that with the traffic of the trains vibrations occur in the land, and since the Bodega is so near, the liquid in the barrels is encouraged to vibrate and fouling is avoided, which is so damaging to the aging process.

This facility, in addition to the areas dedicated exclusively to the creation and work of the Rum Masters and other specialists, has a rum sales and tasting service in its tavern. There is a space dedicated to the typical rums of the city of Santiago de Cuba.

The centennial of the Bodega Don Pancho is an important celebration for the Cuba Ron S.A. Corporation, which is preparing a group of commemorative actions that include the





In order to admire the Bodega Don Pancho, it is necessary to go to Paseo La Alameda, very close to the railway station, and then visitors will find themselves in front of the sacred site that keeps the secrets of Cuban rums. They will also be in the exact coordinates of the place where special rums are produced, in limited editions, with high quality and a high degree of aging, a provocation for the curiosity of collectors and an invitation for those with exquisite palates.

In Santiago de Cuba you can also learn about some myths linked to the manufacture of light rums, as some say that the climate of the region, one of the hottest in the country, together with earthquakes, it is the area of Cuba with the most seismic activity, influence the rums that are produced there.

Others grant the railroad an indirect and almost mystical participation in the process of manufacturing rums in this eastern Cuban city, stating that thanks to its presence the rum



remodeling of the Bodega and other rum production areas. The creation of a limited edition rum has also been proposed, which will also serve to remember such an important moment. 
