
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Hi Friends,



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uba is committed to reinvigorating its tourist activity by diversifying offers and showing its rich history, culture, nature and the hospitality of its people as its main attraction. Air connections are essential when marketing tourism products, and their variety and stability allow travel agencies and tour operators to provide travelers with multiple vacation possibilities throughout the country.

The authorities of the Cuban Ministry of Tourism and the Cuban Airports and Aeronautical Services Company (ECASA), have recently published about the airlines that fly, some regularly and others on seasonal flights, to connect to the largest of the Caribbean islands with vacationers from a growing number of countries and cities. More than 45 international airlines continue to operate in Cuba, including 19 from Latin America, 15 from Europe, 4 from Canada and one from Africa. The most recent news is the restart of Air China operations to Cuba, starting May 17, with two weekly flights on the Beijing-Havana route, with a stopover in Madrid. Here we share the flights of other companies that will also allow the arrival of a greater number of tourists to Cuba in the summer.

We start with Cuba's flagship airline, Cubana de Aviación, which continues with its weekly frequency to Madrid and will add a new route every Sunday to connect Caracas and Havana.

In the Latin American area, Aeroméxico maintains a daily frequency to Havana, which, together with Magnicharter and VivaAerobus flights, constitute the main routes of traveler movements between Cuba and Mexico. The Venezuelan airline Conviasa maintains a biweekly frequency on the Caracas-Havana-Moscow route, while LATAM Airlines adds a fifth frequency to Havana from Lima, thanks

to which it will now have flights on Tuesdays, Thursdays, Fridays, Saturdays and Sunday. Bahamas Air maintains flights from Nassau to Havana, with two weekly frequencies, every Tuesday and Friday. Copa Airlines continues to connect Cuba with Latin American countries, through the Panama City Hub, while Air Century, Intercaribbean, Wingo, Sky Hight and others offer flights to the Dominican Republic and other Caribbean destinations.

Coming from Europe, another group of companies cover the routes between their countries and Cuba. TUI Netherlands maintains a weekly frequency to

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Varadero shared with Cancún; TUI Belgium will have a shared weekly frequency with Cancún and Rossiya Airlines maintains its frequencies to Havana and Varadero. Condor flies as of this May until September 25, with flights to Holguín that will be shared with Montego Bay. Nordwind will operate with four weekly frequencies to Varadero (Mondays, Wednesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays) with other additional flights in May, while operations to Cayo Coco will have two to three weekly frequencies.

Another airline present in the Cuban market is Iberojet, with operations from Madrid to Varadero, from June 1 to October 5, and to Santa Clara, from July 17 to September 4, with a new weekly frequency, on Wednesdays. From Lisbon it will fly to Santa Clara from June 25 to September 10 with a weekly frequency, on Tuesdays. On the other hand, the Neos airline will move its flights from Rome to


Milan from September 9 to October 21, which will be only for Havana (not shared with Cancun).

Iberia maintains three weekly frequencies that connect Havana and Madrid, while Air France offers three weekly frequencies to Havana from Paris, on Mondays, Wednesdays and Saturdays. Turkish Airlines maintains its flights from Istanbul to Havana, with four weekly frequencies: Monday, Tuesday, Friday and Sunday.

World2Fly offers flights from several European cities to Cuba. From Madrid it has already added the fourth frequency to Havana until October 22 and will have a fifth frequency from June 20 to September 12. From Lisbon it will begin operations to Varadero on June 1 until October 26 (Saturdays), and from Lisbon it flies to Cayo Coco, on a new route on Tuesdays, from June 4 to September 24.

We close this route to summer with the only airline that maintains daily flights that connect Havana with Madrid, Air Europa, a Spanish airline member of the SkyTeam alliance that has the most modern and sustainable fleet in the sector and flies to more than 55 destinations in the world.

With all these air connections, a summer full of possibilities and offers from travel agencies, tour operators, hoteliers and other players in the travel industry is on the horizon. From our pages we will continue sharing the good reasons to travel to Cuba, updating professionals and travelers about the openings, renovations and other news of the country's tourist destinations.





Two cultural experiences in Cuba's eastern region



he eastern region of the Cuban archipelago is an essential destination for those seeking to discover the true essence of the country. The new air connections that are being announced open the possibilities for travelers to arrive directly and enjoy what Admiral Christopher Columbus called "the most beautiful land that human eyes have ever seen."

We present two experiences that the Cubanacán group proposes on its official website, where it is also possible to make reservations. The first excursion takes place in the province of Holguín, it is called Gibara Colonial and lasts two hours; it invites travelers to take a panoramic tour of the main streets of this old colonial town, bordering its beautiful bay. Visits will include well-known places such as: Las Madres Park; the old Plaza de Armas, in the center of which stands a miniature replica of the Statue of Liberty; the Plaza de la Cultura and the adjacent institution, headquarters of traditional activities and events.



Excursionists will also have the opportunity to visit several museums, such as the Natural History Museum, with its interesting exhibition of Cuban fauna; that of Municipal History, where pieces of indigenous settlements, documents and belongings of historical figures are displayed; and the Decorative Arts, which houses the largest semicircular stained-glass windows in the eastern part of Cuba. Other interesting stops will be at the Casa del Artesano and the Fernando VII Battery, which overlooks Gibara Bay and was part of its defense system in colonial times.

To enjoy the second excursion, we move to the city of Santiago de Cuba. The tour called Architect's Route proposes a walk through the historic center of the city, where you can appreciate the vibrant mix of Caribbean cultures that define this city. From the majestic Plaza de Céspedes and Heredia Street you will reach the Tívoli neighborhood, a site linked to Santiago's history of music and culture.

This route, inspired by the work of architect Carlos Segrera, initiator of the town's urban progress in the 20th century, will show how his legacy is reflected in the





identity of the city and how his designs have influenced the evolution of architecture in Cuba. Traces of Segrera's creative vision can be found in buildings such as the Cathedral, the Emilio Bacardi Museum, the Government Palace, the Imperial Hotel and the San Carlos Club. The excursion ends with a refreshing cocktail in the Roof Garden of the Casa Granda Hotel, in front of Céspedes Park, famous for the impressive panoramic views of the city seen from there, and which is also related to the figure of the architect Segrera.

Travelers who wish to visit these two cities in eastern Cuba will also be able to stay in facilities of the Cubanacán group itself. In Gibara we suggest the Hotel E Ordoño and in Santiago de Cuba the Imperial and Casa Granda hotels. different certifications. In the first three centers, diving is done from the coast, without the need for boats, the fourth is a cenote with a great variety of fish. In all centers there are certified instructors and professional equipment to carry out this activity.

The temperature of the waters surrounding the Zapata Peninsula remains between 25 and 30 degrees Celsius all year round and the great diversity of underwater flora and fauna is a great attraction for photography. Beautiful coral formations, abundant sponges and a great variety of fish and other marine species have a very well-preserved habitat there.



As a novelty, in this area of Cuba's geography a Deep Apnea Camp is being designed, with a training base in Punta Perdiz and accommodation at the Playa Girón Hotel. This initiative by the Cuban world record holder Pipin Ferreras will allow international freediving teams to carry out their training there at any time of the year, due to the excellent climatic conditions of the peninsula, which, in addition to the sea, has the cenotes in the area, as possible training scenarios.

In the Zapata Peninsula, the Cubanacán Group has, in addition to the Playa Girón Hotel, the Villa Playa Larga, the Villa Batey Don Pedro and the Villa Guamá, one of the most photographed in Cuba.
