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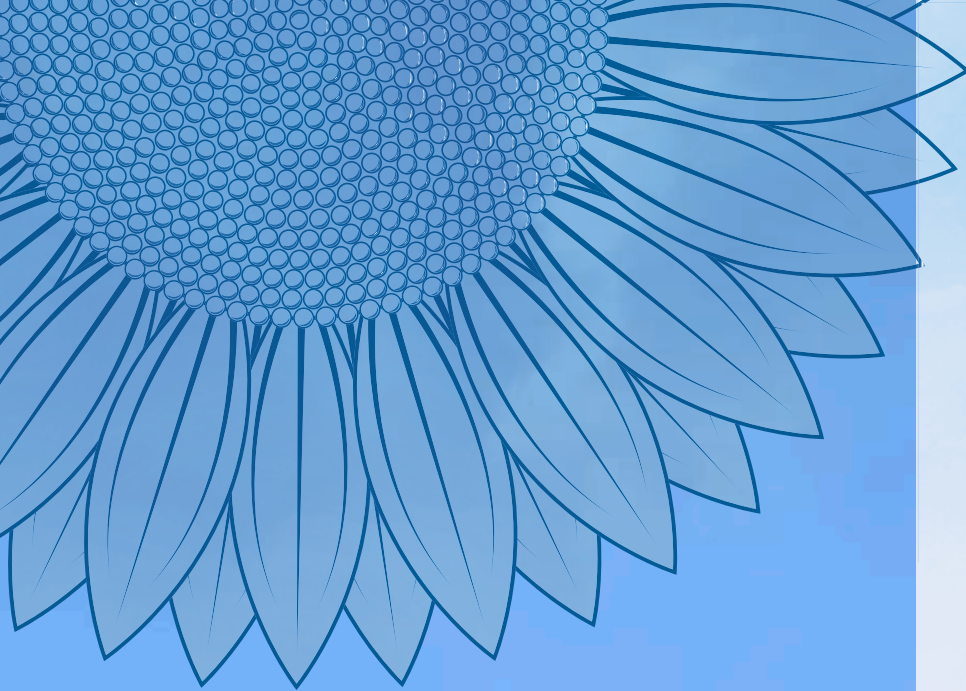
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Hi Friends,

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Topes de Collantes, a natural monument to beauty



The Topes de Collantes Natural Park is a place that nature tourism lovers should visit in Cuba. This Protected Natural Landscape is located halfway between Cienfuegos and Trinidad, in the central region of the country, and treasures numerous natural beauties, of high ecological and botanical value.

Topes de Collantes is located about 800 meters above sea level, 30 kilometers from the city of Trinidad, making it an excellent option for those who are enjoying a stay in that city and wish to get closer to Cuban nature. Topes, as many simply call it, has numerous caves, rivers, waterfalls and cascades, of which the most famous is the Caburní.

More than 15 species of pine, 12 species of eucalyptus and more than 100 ornamental plants are responsible for the flowers in Topes de Collantes all year round. Among them, the

Butterfly Jasmin (*Hedychium coronarium*) stands out, which is the National Flower. A great variety of ferns, medicinal plants, wild orchids and others complement the beautiful surroundings.

The forest wealth includes the presence of carob trees, cedars, mahogany, as well as magnolia and teak trees. They shelter a varied fauna, with a large representation of invertebrates, although without the presence of species that could be dangerous to man. Forty-five percent of the birds that live there are endemic to Cuba. The complicated mountainous relief offers visitors a landscape in which heights of different ranges alternate, together with small and fertile valleys.

There are many trails, excursions and programs that have been designed to enjoy the beauty of Topes de Collantes and among them stands out the visit to El Nicho, a place where travelers will find a



group of streams and waterfalls that form a dreamlike visual spectacle. They are surrounded by lush tropical vegetation, and in them you can cool off and swim to your liking, either under the torrent of water or in the natural pools that are formed there.

Around the area there are caves to explore with specialized guides, the most striking being the Martín Infierno, where a 67- meter-high stalagmite is found, the largest in Latin America. El Nicho is the home par excellence of the tocororo, Cuba's national bird, whose colors recall those of its flag. There, in addition to relaxing with the view of the waterfalls and the trails that cross interesting places, travelers will find the options offered by the local gastronomy, in the purest rural environment.



Every year Topes de Collantes becomes the stage for the Digital Nature International Photography Contest, organized by the Gaviota Group and convened by professional and amateur photographers from around the world. Impressive images have been awarded in its different editions, in the categories of Landscape, Flora and Fauna, Macro-photography and the one dedicated to the relationship between Man and Nature. The event is a unique opportunity to capture the essence of this tourist destination, and contributes to promoting it through the photographs taken by its participants.

The respectful relationship between tourism development and environmental conservation in Topes de Collantes is an example that the desired balance between enjoyment and conservation is possible. Recently it was announced that specialists from the Office of the Conservator of the City of Trinidad and the Valle de los Ingenios (OCC) are working to declare Topes de Collantes a National Monument of Cuba. Will this be a guarantee for that place in Cuban geography that is already a monument to beauty.

Brisas Sierra Mar-Los Galeones Caring for natural spaces



In Santiago de Cuba, the Brisas Sierra Mar-Los Galeones hotel complex, managed by the Cubanacán group, is committed to protecting its beaches to keep being a sustainable option in terms of nature tourism.

Sierra Mar-Los Galeones is a space surrounded by unparalleled marine and land ecosystems, whose care is promoted through a cooperation project with the University of Oriente. This house of higher learning, together with the Ibero-American Node of the Centre for Multidisciplinary Studies of Coastal Zones and the Ibero-American Proplayas Network, is working on cleaning up the hotel's beaches to obtain the Blue Flag, an international award that measures the quality in the management of these sites.

At the hotel, located 62 kilometers from the historic center of Santiago de Cuba, the beach

next to the Sierra Mar block is made of black volcanic sand, while the Los Galeones section with a panoramic view of the bay and the town of Chivirico has a white sandy beach. Located on the slope of a mountain, shaped like a terrace and surrounded by a sea of warm and crystalline waters, the space exploits all the natural benefits it has. At its nautical point, catamaran rides, speedboats and kayaks are offered, as well as diving possibilities.

In the complex there is also the possibility of practicing health tourism with a center for the treatment of various diseases with thermal waters. The proximity to Pico Turquino, the Sierra Maestra and the sea allows visitors to live a unique experience, since they can enjoy nature from the protection of the mangroves, coral reefs and species of flora and fauna that inhabit them.

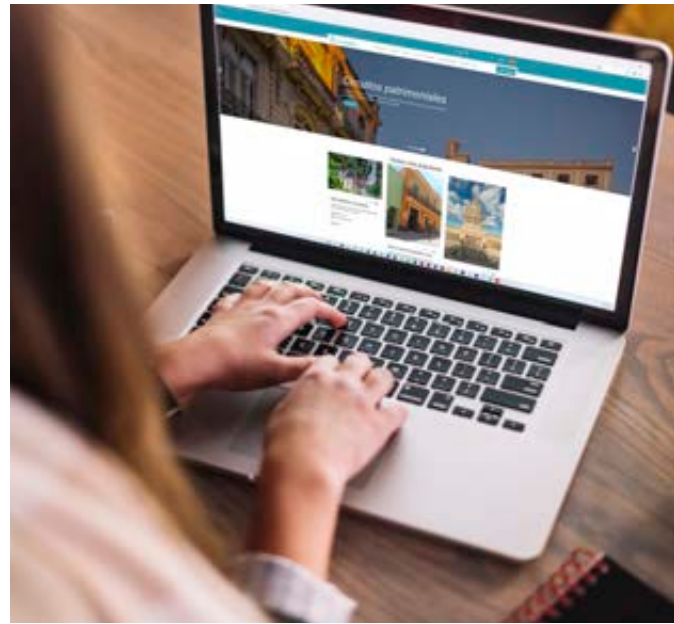

This will allow better use of the available resources to produce goods and services, reduce the consumption of raw materials, water and energy sources and promote the recycling of materials to convert them into new products.

La Gran Piedra Hotel, a place for nature lovers

The La Gran Piedra Hotel, belonging to the Islazul group, is located in a privileged setting in eastern Cuba. Its name comes from one of the most important geological values of the largest of the Caribbean islands: an enormous 51-meter-long, 25-meter-high and 30-meter-wide block of volcanic rock with an estimated weight of approximately 70,000 tons, dimensions that have given it the Guinness record for being the rock of its size at the highest altitude in the world.

About 26 kilometers from the city of Santiago de Cuba, the hotel is located in the Baconao Park Biosphere Reserve, an area of great historical, heritage and landscape attractions. Many beauties await tourists at these heights – nearly 1,234 meters above sea level – and just one kilometer away is



the Botanical Garden, where exceptional species of flora such as the bird of paradise, dahlias, magnolias and others from cold climates are cultivated, taking advantage of the microclimate that prevails in the area.



With a two-star category, the La Gran Piedra Hotel has 22 rooms in cabanas and bungalows, a cafeteria, bar and restaurant. For lovers of nature tourism staying at the hotel, climbing the 459 steps to the Gran Piedra lookout point is usually



an unforgettable experience. Along the way, several hundred plant species can be observed, including 222 ferns, 352 orchids, eucalyptus, cypresses and a great variety of fruit trees. Added to this is a fauna with 926 species, including the tocororo, Cuba's national bird, and the Cuban Greta butterfly, whose transparent wings make it almost invisible. Finally, at the top of the climb, the contrast between the panoramic views of the coast and the Sierra Maestra puts the finishing touch to the effort made.

The La Gran Piedra Hotel can also be integrated with the Los Caminos del Café project, so its guests can take guided tours to the Museo Cafetal La Isabelica, an important piece of the Archaeological Landscape of the first coffee plantations in the southeast of Cuba. This group of old coffee plantations is recognized by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site.

Due to its importance and value, the Gran Piedra and the facilities surrounding it were declared a National Monument of Cuba in 1991.

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The “Golden Triangle” of the city of Camagüey



The city of Camagüey, in the central-eastern region of Cuba, was founded in 1514 with the name Santa María del Puerto del Príncipe. Today it offers numerous attractions that include it among the main tourist destinations in the country.

Among them is the so-called “Golden Triangle,” an urban space formed by Maceo, Ignacio Agramonte and Independencia streets. According to the local press, this is one of the busiest areas of the city, and it takes center stage not only for the number of leisure facilities it houses, but also for its architectural and cultural characteristics.



This area is located in the historic center of the city, one of the largest in Cuba, which was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 2008. There, specialists from the Office of the Historian of Camagüey maintain various programs of conservation and local development.

Travelers can also find various accommodations, including the Hotel E Santa María, which belongs to the Cubanacán Group and the Gran Hotel. Also in the aforementioned Triangle, you can find bars and restaurants with different specialties. There is also a tourist information center and the birthplace of Ignacio Agramonte, hero of the Cuban wars for independence in the 19th century.



Nearby you can admire the Nuestra Señora de la Merced church and walking a little further on you reach the very popular Callejón de los Milagros, a thematic walk dedicated to cinema and unique of its kind in Cuba.

Renowned for its tradition of artisans and potters, along with the whimsical layout of its streets, Camagüey is the birthplace of very illustrious figures in Cuban history, such as National Poet Nicolás Guillén (1902-1989), or scientist Carlos J. Finlay, (1833-1915), discoverer of the agent that transmits yellow fever.

The city of Camagüey is also recognized as the Cradle of Cuban Literature, since the first literary work known in this country was written within its perimeter: the epic poem "Espejo de Paciencia," attributed to Silvestre de Balboa and dating from the year 1608.

From our pages we invite you to discover this Cuban heritage city, where history and modernity go hand in hand and where you can enjoy a stay full of unique experiences. Today we have presented a space in the city with the suggestive name of the "Golden Triangle," but there are many other attractions that you can discover in Camagüey, because this is a city to which you can return and you will always find something new that captivates you.
